

Class Schedule

Syllabus must include or refer to a schedule of classes for the course, including the amount of time scheduled for each class.



Time in Class

A 50 minute lecture class period will be considered a reasonable approximation to one hour, since it conforms to commonly accepted practice in higher education.



Amount of Homework

Syllabus should state the number of hours students are expected to spend on homework assignments each week.




Grading

Faculty Meeting Minutes

Held July 8, 2015

There were 16 persons in attendance at our Summer Quarter Faculty Meeting.

The major highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- The meeting commenced at 6:10pm opening with the reading of the Mission Statement.
- The relevant introductions of faculty members and staff were carried out accordingly.
- Radio Manager, Robert Lynch, introduced our Learning Management
 System, Populi, to our new instructors and did a short presentation on the benefits of our new Icci email educational (icci.edu.ky) domain.
- The Dean, Melisa Bent-Hamilton, discussed the contents of the Orientation Package and reminded the group of some of the essentials of a good syllabus. As promised, all syllabi have been created and posted on Populi.
 Instructors were reminded to log on and confirm its content.
- Ms. Michelle Gray-Williams, our on-site librarian, reminded instructors of the multi-media resources available to them; both online and on site. She

also mentioned that she will be conducting a presentation on plagiarism, especially for courses such as AP 140, EN 100, EN 090, EN 101, and EN 102.

- Dr. Marshall gave us updates from our accrediting body, ACICS, assessment
 of student learning, IACBE membership, course grade distributions, faculty
 evaluations by student and discussed the launch of our hybrid/online
 courses in the Summer quarter.
- Questions and answers were entertained with faculty members and the administrative team.
- The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
